



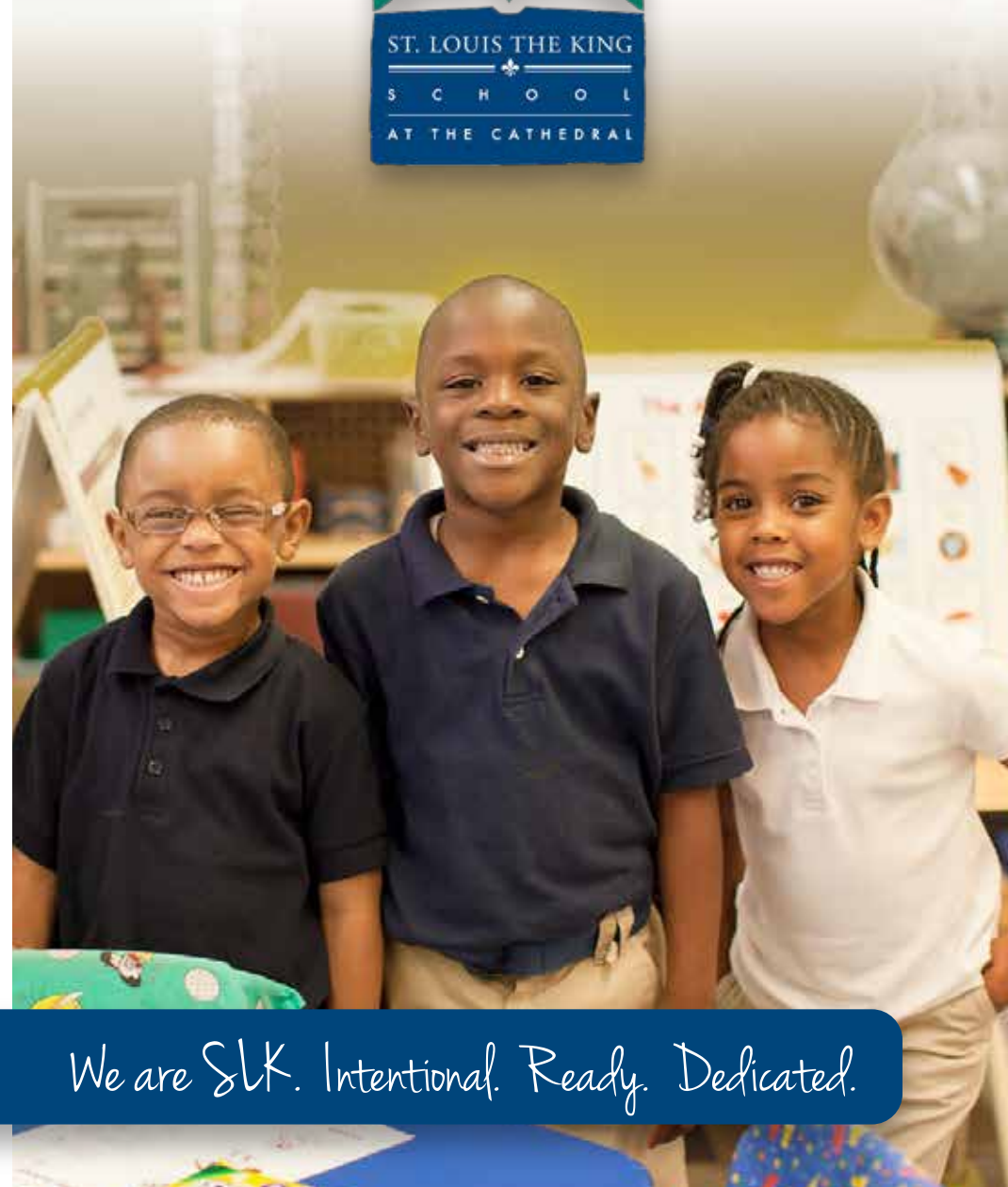

History of Saint Louis the King School at the Cathedral

Founded in 2012, St. Louis the King School at the Cathedral blends the rich histories and traditions of both The Cathedral School and Central Catholic School. St. Louis the King School at the Cathedral is the result of the Archdiocese of St. Louis' emphasis on Catholic education and focus to offer a quality, Catholic education to any family in St. Louis that seek it. At St. Louis the King, we believe families should have the ability to choose the school that best meets their child's educational needs, regardless of their ability to pay. The King is located in the Central West End neighborhood on the Cathedral Basilica campus. Being neighbors, our students celebrate weekly mass in the Cathedral surrounded by the mosaic tile stories and history of our Catholic faith. They regularly experience what visitors from around the world make as a destination.



We are a community of Superheroes. From our parents to our dedicated faculty to our young kindergarten students, **we are ordinary people doing extraordinary things every day.**

Our parents are intentional in choosing St. Louis the King School for their children. The majority of our students are living in single-parent households at or below the poverty level. Our families understand that a school/family partnership is a sure way to break the cycle of poverty. With that said, our parents travel from 22 zip codes to place their children at the King knowing they are safe and secure, learning academically, and

growing spiritually and emotionally. Our parents are involved in their child's education by making a personal financial commitment as best they can, attending school conferences, volunteering at our Lenten Fish Fries, and participating in PTO activities.

A dedicated faculty supports every student and family. Our faculty understands a student's social, emotional, and physical needs being unmet impacts their ability to learn and the ability for a class to create community and learn together. Knowing this, our class sizes are small and our teachers are proactive. We serve two hot meals and snacks every school day. We partner with MercyKids to have a social worker on campus to work with students beyond their educational needs, and also work with our faculty to identify cues from students that are underneath the surface. Additionally, we offer an extended school day and school year recognizing an opportunity to enrich the educational experience of students with programs such as Building Futures, a STEM program (science, technology, engineering and math), Girl Scouts, and Man Up.

The King is in it for the long term. With support from our funding partners, our students have access to the best college preparatory high schools with continued tuition assistance scholarships and a graduate support program that works with each family to ensure our students are thriving.
